

## REPAIR AFFAIR PROGRAM

- Do you live in the City of Paducah?
- Do you own your house?
- Do you need minor home repair help?
- Does your household income fall below the Area Median Income?

Repair Affair is a volunteer-based program. The work that can be completed depends on the number and skill level of volunteers.

Repairs may include yard work, flooring, steps, door/window repair, minor plumbing, electrical or mechanical repairs, exterior/interior painting, roof work, drywall repair, etc.

## EMERGENCY REPAIR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

- Are you on disability?
- Are you 60 years old or older?
- Do you own your house?
- Do you need to make your home more accessible?
- Do your home have a safety issue?
- Does your household income fall below the Area Median Income?

Repairs may include installing grab-bars, handrails, and ramps, repairing plumbing, wiring, heating, or roofing to make your home safe.

Emergency Repair Assistance Program is only for disabled and elderly homeowners. Prior to work you must show proof of disability or age.

These programs are **NOT** a re-decorating, remodeling, or total rehab program.

Typical repairs focus on safety, security, accessibility, maintenance, and weatherization.

All applicants will be contacted. Midtown Alliance of Neighbors staff will talk with you and come for a site visit.

If your home is chosen for either program, you will be asked to provide documents:

1. Confirming income (Social Security Income, pay stub, etc)
2. Proof of ownership (deed).

**2014 funds may not be available to help all applicants.** Applicants will be helped based on income, severity of need, and availability of volunteers. Others who qualified will be placed on a waiting list. If project is too big for program, we will work with you to find other resources.
